ABSTRACT

The Northern Kentucky University College of Arts and Sciences originated from the first academic offerings of Northern Kentucky State College (Northern Kentucky University's predecessor). These disciplines formed the academic base that became the College of Arts and Sciences. The College of Art and Sciences records contain administrative, faculty, student and foundation records. These records document the development and administration of the college and the evolution of the college's departments, programs, centers and institutes through its fifty plus years' history.

ADMINISTRATIVE/BIOGRAPHICAL HISTORY

Northern Kentucky University's (NKU) start came from the University of Kentucky's extension centers/community college system. The University of Kentucky Northern Extension Center (UKNEC) and University of Kentucky Northern Community College (UKNCC) were predecessors to Northern Kentucky State College (NKSC) which became Northern Kentucky University (NKU).

On March 14, 1968, Governor Louis B. Nunn signed House Bill 255 authorizing the establishment of a four-year state college in northern Kentucky, Northern Kentucky State College. This passage of this bill began the transition of UKNCC, a community college, to NKSC, an independent four-year college. By July 31, 1969, all UKNCC assets were fully transferred to NKSC.

The addition of Chase College of Law (1972) and a graduate program in education (1974) signaled a needed status change from an undergraduate college to a university.² On February 25, 1976, Governor Julian Carroll signed House Bill 180, formally changing Northern Kentucky State College to Northern Kentucky University, effective June 19, 1976.

The origins of the College of Arts and Sciences can be traced directly to the original academic offerings at NKSC. The NKSC 1970-1971 course catalog identified eight areas of general study³:

- Behavioral Sciences
- Biological Sciences
- Foreign Languages
- History
- Humanities: Literature, Art and Music
- Mathematics-Philosophy
- Physical Sciences
- Social Sciences

All of these disciplines and their course offerings, excluding Economics in Social Sciences, formed the academic base that became the NKU College of Arts and Sciences.

NKSC's move to university status necessitated structural changes and in April 1977, President A. D. Albright began a major reorganization of the newly established Northern Kentucky University. The academic programs of the university divided into four distinct units composed of multiple departments: Basic Disciplinary Programs, Human Development and Services Programs, Legal Education Programs and Experimental Programs, with each unit headed by a dean.⁴ Dr. Lyle Gray served as the first dean for the Basic Disciplinary Programs, beginning that role in January 1978.⁵

From 1977-1979, the College of Arts and Sciences operated under the name Basic Disciplinary Programs. This unit contained these initial departments:

- Biological Sciences Program
- Fine Arts Program
- Government and Public Affairs Program
- History Program
- Humanities Program
- Mathematical Science Program
- Physical Science Program
- Psychology Program
- Social Sciences Program

On January 1, 1980, the Basic Disciplinary Programs was officially renamed and became Arts and Sciences with the following departments⁶:

- Biological Sciences
- Fine Arts
- History and Geography
- Literature and Language
- Mathematical Sciences
- Physical Sciences
- Political Science
- Psychology
- Social Sciences

Arts and Sciences officially added "college" to their name in August 1982 to become the College of Arts and Sciences.⁷

Experimental Programs, which later included Interdisciplinary Programs, began as a separate unit in 1977 but it subsequently became part of the College of Arts and Sciences.⁸

Through the years as the structure of the college evolved, different disciplines and support functions were created, expanded, renamed, dissolved, or moved within the college or outside the college.

Some of the major shifts included:

- In the 1970's, Business/Economics, Communications, Education, Social Work and Public Administration moved to Human Development and Service Programs.
- In the 1990's, the Learning Assistance Program and Developmental Mathematics moved to other units in Academic Affairs.
- In 1999, the establishment of centers and institutes began. Not all of these
 units appeared on the organizational chart. Only CINSAM and the
 Kentucky Center for Mathematics remain in the College of Arts and
 Sciences. Some centers/institutes were short-lived.
- In the 2000's, Liberal Studies, Women's and Gender Studies offered, Computer Science moved to the College of Informatics and the Center for Environmental Restoration moved to Graduate Education, Research and Outreach.
- In 2015 the School of the Arts was established. The departments of Music, Theatre and Dance, and Visual Arts became programs within the school.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The College of Art and Sciences Record Group RG-013 contains records dating to the beginning of Northern Kentucky University, originally Northern Kentucky State College. These records document the development and administration of this college and the evolution of the college's departments, programs, centers and institutes.

The processing level of the records varies from completely processed and organized to minimally processed with unsorted records.

Records from departments and units that originated in the College of Arts and Sciences, but subsequently moved to another college or unit outside of the college, will be maintained in the subsequent college's or unit's Record Group.

Multiple record transfers from University Printing contributed to the amount of Print Materials Subseries in each Subgroup.

This is an open Record Group meaning new additions are expected to be received.

There are twenty-two (22) Subgroups in this Record Group. Subgroups I-XVI could contain four (4) series: Administrative Records, Faculty Records, Student Records and Foundation/Friends Records. Subgroups XVII-XXII have one (1) series: Administrative Records.

Subgroup I, Office of the Dean Records (1976-2018), contains Administrative Records and Faculty Records. The Administrative Records include strategic plans;

committee meeting records; publications; print materials; event records; two academic programs' records - Experimental Programs and Interdisciplinary Studies; and memorabilia. The Faculty Records include correspondence and syllabi.

Subgroup II, Mixed Department Records (1971-2018), contains Administrative Records which include a variety of print materials from different College of Arts and Sciences departments/programs, mostly unsorted.

Subgroup III, Biological Sciences Records (1984-2015), contains Administrative Records and Faculty Records. The Administrative Records include department history, student award guidelines, publications and print materials. The Faculty Records consist of syllabi guidelines and syllabi.

Subgroup IV, Chemistry Records (1977-2011), contains Administrative Records and Faculty Records. The Administrative Records include publications and print materials. The Faculty Records consist of syllabi.

Subgroup V, English Records (1970-2021), contains Administrative Records, Faculty Records and Student Records. The Administrative Records include department handbooks, publications, print materials, event records and memorabilia. The Faculty Records consist of reappointment, promotion, tenure and instructional handbooks, and syllabi. The Student Records include honor society records and publications.

Subgroup VI, History and Geography Records (1981-2013), contains Administrative Records and Faculty Records. The Administrative Records include Masters in Liberal Studies degree development records, committee records, publications, print materials, event records and memorabilia. The Faculty Records consist of handbooks, correspondence, event records and syllabi.

Subgroup VII, Mathematics and Statistics Records (1978-2011), contains Administrative Records and Faculty Records. The Administrative Records include a variety of print materials. The Faculty Records consist of syllabi.

Subgroup VIII, Physics, Geology, and Engineering Technology Records (1984-2010), contains Administrative Records and Faculty Records. The Administrative Records include publications and print materials. The Faculty Records consist of syllabi.

Subgroup IX, Political Science, Criminal Justice, and Organizational Leadership Records (1977-2015), contains Administrative Records which include the graduate advising handbook, print materials and event records.

Subgroup X, Psychological Science Records (1990-2018), contains Administrative Records, Faculty Records and Student Records. The Administrative Records include publications, print materials and event records. The Faculty Records consist of syllabi. The Student Records include honor society magazines and newsletters, and undergraduate honors theses.

Subgroup XI, School of the Arts Director/Mixed Program Records (1970-2021), contains Administrative Records and Foundation/Friends Records. The Administrative Records include print materials and newspaper clipping scrapbooks. The Foundation/Friends Records consist of a mission statement, event records, newspaper clippings/photographs scrapbook and memorabilia.

Subgroup XII, School of the Arts – Art & Design Program Records (1978-2019), contains Administrative Records and Faculty Records. The Administrative Records include publications, print materials and exhibit records. The Faculty Records consist of exhibit records. The Student Records include print materials and exhibit records.

Subgroup XIII, School of the Arts – Music Program Records (1973-2022), contains Administrative Records and Faculty Records. The Administrative Records include print materials, performance records and a scholarship award listing. The Faculty Records consist of performance records. The Student Records include a student handbook and performance records.

Subgroup XIV, School of the Arts – Theatre & Dance Program Records (1972-2023), contains Administrative Records and Student Records. The Administrative Records include YES Festival grant records, correspondence, scholarship recipients list, print materials, performance records, press releases and newspaper clippings. The Student Records consist of handbooks, performance records and memorabilia.

Subgroup XV, Sociology, Anthropology, and Philosophy Records (1979-2018), contains Administrative Records, Faculty Records and Student Records. The Administrative Records include department history, print materials and event records. The Faculty Records consist of syllabi. The Student Records include handbooks.

Subgroup XVI, World Languages and Literatures Records (2001-2022), contains Administrative Records and Student Records. The Administrative Records include publications and print materials. The Student Records consist of event records.

Subgroup XVII, Burkhardt Consulting Center Records (2006-2008), contains Administrative Records which consist of print materials.

Subgroup XVIII, Center for Integrative Natural Science and Mathematics (CINSAM) Records (2001-2013), contains Administrative Records which consist of annual reports, print materials and event records.

Subgroup XIX, Holocaust Education Resource Center Records (2004-2005), contains Administrative Records which consist of print materials.

Subgroup XX, Institute for Freedom Studies Records (2001-2004), contains Administrative Records which consist of publications, print materials and event records.

Subgroup XXI, Institute for Public Leadership and Public Affairs Records (2006-2007), contains Administrative Records which consist of print materials.

Subgroup XXII, Kentucky Center for Mathematics Records (2010-2011), contains Administrative Records which consist of print materials and event records.
