Fifty-two on-the-job injuries were reported by NKU employees in the period from January 1, 1983 to December 31, 1983. These injuries accounted for 52 lost workdays and \$2,970.68 in lost wages; the related medical expenses totaled \$4,479.88.

An employee injured on the job should report to the campus nurse or family physician as soon as possible. Be careful and stay healthy.
