When filing your 1040, 1040A or 1040EZ...BE ADVISED that you must report the wages listed in block #10 of your W-2 form. Block #10 reflects your total gross wages after the tax sheltered salary reduction from retirement. A supply of commonly used tax forms are available in the Personnel Office.
