Dr. Williams then opened the floor for other nominations.

President.

There were no other nominations for President. L. Giesmann moved to elect Jonathan Bushee President, by acclamation. D. Kelm seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Vice President.

There were no other nominations for Vice President. B. Dickens moved to elect Jim Fouche' Vice President by acclamation. T. Cate seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Secretary.

There were no other nominations for Secretary. B. Gwynn moved to elect Connie Mulligan-Nichols by acclamation. B. Renz seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Parliamentarian

There were no other nominations for Parliamentarian. J. Johnson moved to elect Beth Gwynn by acclamation. D. Elder seconded the motion. Motion passed. Professional Concerns Committee.

There were no other nominations. J. Fouche' moved to elect Doris Brett by acclamation. R. Singh seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Curriculum Committee.

There were no other nominations from the floor. D. Kelm moved to elect Jim Hopgood by acclamation. R. Gardella seconded the motion. Motion passed. Faculty Benefits Committee.

There were no other nominations from the floor. R. Vitz moved to elect Arthur Miller by acclamation. Connie Mulligan-Nichols seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Budget Committee.

R. Vitz declined the nomination. J. Miller nominated Terry McNally. J. Hopgood seconded the motion. J. Hopgood nominated Ken Bierne. R. Singh seconded the motion. J. Fouche' nominated Byron Renz. T. McNally seconded

the motion. On the written ballot Renz received 17 votes and Beirne 9. Renz was elected chairperson of the Budget Committee.

Dr. Williams announced that Senate activities will continue through the summer. T. McNally suggested streamlining senate meetings, perhaps by using written committee reports. W. Dickens suggested scheduling committee meetings regularly on a yearly basis.

J. Bushee announced that notices would be sent soon regarding future committee assignments. Other suggestions for the future included more grassroots support and a better room.

The first meeting of the new Senate is tentatively set for July 10, 1979.

J. Williams noted appreciation for E. Goggin's service to the Senate over the past few years. B. Gwynn seconded the motion. Motion approved. A letter of appreciation will be sent to Professor Goggin.
