SUBJECT: Singh Report Recommendations

During the Fall Semester Dr. Raymon Singh presented a proposal to the Executive Committee, Benefits Committee Chair, and Professional Concerns Chair outlining recommendations for changes in the way faculty are compensated for Summer at NKU (copy of proposal being provided to Senators). The Faculty Benefits Committee asked Dr. Singh to present his proposal earlier this Semester and the Committee has discussed it on several occasions. Based on the proposal and ensuing discussions, the Faculty Benefits Committee make the following recommendations for consideration by the Senate:

1. TIAA/CREFF retirement benefits be made a part of faculty salaries for Summer School teaching.
2. The cap for Summer School salary be raised each year the same percentage as the percentage of salary raise for the university from the previous year.
3. The level of pay be raised from 9% (for a three hour class) to 15% (for a three hour class) for Summer School teaching.
