SYNOPSIS OF STAFF CONGRESS MEETING June 8, 1989:

--The next Staff Congress meeting will be held on July 13, 1989 in the University Ballroom, 1:00-3:00 p.m. Guests from the University community are welcome. However, if you wish to raise a topic for discussion, please notify Diane Hunley two weeks prior to the meeting, so that you can be put on the agenda.

--The meeting was preceded by a reception for our scholarship recipients Aprile Conrad and Amber Gosney, daughters of Lillian Conrad and Marilyn Gosney.

--Peg Goodrich presented President Diane Hunley with a plaque to show our appreciation for Diane's contribution to Staff Congress.

--BENEFITS presented a recommendation for changes concerning Unpaid Medical Leave and a recommendation for implementation of a Short Term Disability Insurance Plan. Both recommendations passed.

--CREDENTIALS & ELECTIONS reported that just under 50% of all ballots were returned. Nominations for the executive council will be taken at the July meeting. Thus far we have Donna Gosney running for President, Sue Roth and Virginia Stallings running for Vice President and Lillian Conrad running for Secretary. Your nomination may be submitted to Peg X-6400 or Diane X-5202 prior to the July meeting.

--POLICIES presented a recommendation concerning questions on three policy drafts - Reorganization & Reassignment - Reclassification - and the Position Classification System. It passed. Cathy Dewberry resigned from Staff Congress, leaving a vacancy in the Professional category.

--LIAISON presented draft #2 of the Staff Congress Brochure.

--FOOD SERVICE ADVISORY pointed out an error in the May issue of the Newsletter - Bids will not be taken to replace Skyline Chili.

--SALARY ADMINISTRATION CONSULTANT. A preliminary report is anticipated as early as mid July, with a final report possibly in the fall.

--DRUG FREE WORKPLACE presented a recommendation that Congress accept the Policy as written. It passed.

--STRATEGIC PLAN presented a recommendation for changes concerning the Revised Draft of the Institutional Strategic Plan. It passed.

--SCHOLARSHIP presented a recommendation concerning future requirements. It passed.
