-- Peg Goodrich presented President Diane Hunley with a plaque to show our appreciation for Diane's contribution to Staff Congress.

--BENEFITS presented a recommendation for changes concerning Unpaid Medical Leave and a recommendation for implementation of a Short Term Disability Insurance Plan. Both

recommendations passed.

--CREDENTIALS & ELECTIONS reported that just under 50% of all ballots were returned. Nominations for the executive council will be taken at the July meeting. Thus far we have Donna Gosney running for President, Sue Roth and Virginia Stallings running for Vice President and Lillian Conrad running for Secretary.
