Ms. Green -

Your letter asking my consent to impose in you the sacred trust and keeping of my darling Retta, has been recd [received]. It is true, I have thought for some time that, there was something of the kind in existance [existence].

As I know her to be a girl of discretion and good judgment, beleive [believe] she would be equally so, in the matter of so great importance, as the selection of one to whom she surrenders her rights, her liberties, her very fate.

The happiness [happiness] of my children is the chief object of my life, and having nothing to urge in opposition to your request, save the

selfishnefs wish of always retaining my jewel in my own keeping - yet this sacrifice, <u>great as it is</u>, I'm willing to make, if granting my consent in this matter will contribute to her happinefs [happiness]. May God take you both in his special protection, preserve you from the various evils by which you are surrounded and make you ever mindful, that the consciousnefs [consciousness] of making each other happy, should be your purest happinefs [happiness] I remain
