

### **FRED HERSCH**

The Board of Regents at Northern Kentucky University is pleased to award an honorary degree to Fred Hersch.

### **DOCTOR OF MUSICAL ARTS**

Proclaimed by Vanity Fair "the most arrestingly innovative planist in jazz over the last decade," Fred Hersch balances his internationally recognized instrumental and composing skills with significant achievements as a bandleader, collaborator and theatrical conceptualist. In 2006 he became the first artist in the 75-year history of New York's legendary Village Vanguard to play a weeklong engagement as a solo pianist. His second solo run at the Vanguard was documented on the 2011 release Alone at the Vanguard, which received Grammy Award nominations for Best Jazz Album and Best Improvised Jazz Solo-two of the eight Grammy nominations Hersch has earned in his more than three dozen recordings as a leader and co-leader

Hersch's latest trio CD with bassist John Hebert and drummer Eric McPherson, Floating (Palmetto) was nominated for two 2015 Grammy awards in the Best Jazz Album and Best Jazz Solo Edition Peters published these compositions. categories. 

# **POSTHUMOUS DEGREE RECIPIENT**



**GARY WEBB** 

The Board of Regents at Northern Kentucky University is pleased to award a posthumous degree to Gary Webb.

### BACHELOR OF ARTS IN JOURNALISM

Gary Webb was an investigative reporter who got his start working as a student reporter at Northern Kentucky University's independent student newspaper, *The Northerner*. Mr. Webb didn't finish college, electing instead to become a full-time reporter for *The Kentucky Post* in 1978, where he developed a taste for investigative reporting.

His work at *The Post* was recognized with a national Investigative Reporters and Editors Award for a 17-part series examining the murder of a coal company president with ties to organized crime. He then moved to the *Cleveland Plain Dealer*, where his investigation into problems with Ohio's State Medical Board earned more accolades.

Mr. Webb won more than 30 journalism awards during his career. Many of those were earned during his time at the *San Jose Mercury News* 

where his work focused on government and private-sector corruption. He was one of six reporters at the *Mercury News* to win a 1990 Pulitzer Prize for General News Reporting for a series of stories on the collapse of the Cypress Street Viaduct during northern California's 1989 earthquake. He also received the 1997 Media Hero Award from the Institute for Alternative Journalism and in 1996 was named Journalist of the Year by the Bay Area Society of Professional Journalists.

In August 1996 the *Mercury News* published Mr. Webb's "Dark Alliance," a 20,000-word, three-part investigative series which alleged that Nicaraguan drug traffickers had sold and distributed crack cocaine in Los Angeles during the 1980s, and that drug profits were used to fund the CIA-supported Nicaraguan Contras. "Dark Alliance" received national attention. According to the *Columbia Journalism Review*, the series became "the most talked-about piece of journalism in 1996 and arguably the most famous – some would say infamous – set of articles of the decade."

Mr. Webb reported that many African Americans who had never connected to the Internet before began using the Internet to read his story. "Dark Alliance" created a great controversy and three of America's largest newspapers – *The New York Times*, the *Los Angeles Times*, and *The Washington Post* – followed up with reports questioning his conclusions. As a result, the *Mercury News* came under considerable pressure for publishing and supporting the "Dark Alliance" series. Mr. Webb was effectively forced out of his job after the *Mercury News* decided to retract its support for the series.

"Authentic journalism is telling people something that the government doesn't want them to know," Mr. Webb once said. He took that responsibility seriously, and others noticed. In a review of the "Dark Alliance" series printed in the *Baltimore Sun*, former executive director of Investigative Reporters and Editors Steve Weinberg wrote that, "Despite some hyped phrasing, 'Dark Alliance' appears to be praiseworthy investigative reporting." The Northern California branch of the national Society of Professional Journalists agreed, voting Mr. Webb its "Journalist of the Year" for 1996.

After leaving the *Mercury News*, he worked as an investigator for the California State Legislature and then the Legislature's Office of Majority Services. He also continued to do freelance reporting.

In 1998, Mr. Webb expanded the controversial series into a book he published titled "Dark Alliance: The CIA, the Contras, and the Crack Cocaine Explosion." The book won the Pen Oakland Censorship Award and a Firecracker Alternative Book Award the following year.

His story gained new notoriety in 2014 with the release of the feature film "Kill the Messenger," based on his book. The movie, starring Jeremy Renner as Mr. Webb, takes place during his *Mercury News* days and documents the pressure he faced not to publish the "Dark Alliance" series and the personal attacks he faced after its publication. The film was released to critical acclaim.

Mr. Webb was married to Susan Bell from 1979-2000 and they had three children, Ian, Eric, and Christine.

In a chapter he contributed to "The Mighty Wurlitzer Plays On," Mr. Webb wrote about the "Dark Alliance" controversy. "If we had met five years ago, you wouldn't have found a more staunch defender of the newspaper industry than me...," he wrote. "And then I wrote some stories that made me realize how sadly misplaced my bliss had been. The reason I'd enjoyed such smooth sailing for so long hadn't been, as I'd assumed, because I was careful and diligent and good at my job...The trust was that, in all those years, I hadn't written anything important enough to suppress..."

After struggling with depression after the controversy, Mr. Webb committed suicide in 2004.



### COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY

Commencement exercises today at Northern Kentucky University give special attention to the pageantry of the ceremony. The counterpart of this pageantry is enacted each year on campuses all over the world. It is the solemn climax and recognition of the graduates' years of study and preparation for increased responsibility.

### **HISTORY OF ACADEMIC COSTUME**

The history of academic dress reaches far back into the early days of the oldest universities. A statute of 1321 required that all "Doctors, Licentiates, and Bachelors" of the University of Coimbra wear gowns. In England, in the second half of the fourteenth century, the statutes of certain colleges forbade "excess in apparel" and prescribed the wearing of a long gown. It is still unknown whether academic dress finds its sources chiefly in ecclesiastical or in civilian dress. Gowns may have been counted necessary for warmth in the unheated buildings frequented by medieval scholars. Hoods seem to have served to cover the tonsured head until they were superseded by skull caps. These were themselves displaced by a headdress somewhat like those now recognized as "academic." Both Cambridge and Oxford have made academic dress a matter of university control to the extent of minor details and have repeatedly issued revised regulations governing it. In seventeenthcentury Oxford it was prescribed that any tailor who departed from the authorized design "by a nail's breadth" in the making of any article of collegiate costume was to be punished by the vicechancellor of the university.

European institutions continue to show a great diversity in their specifications of academic dress, while American colleges and universities have adopted, through the Intercollegiate Bureau of Academic Costume and the American Council of Education, a standard code of dress for academic ceremony Created in 1902, the Intercollegiate Bureau of Academic Costume serves as a source of information and guidance in such matters and, through occasional review by the American Council of Education, these standards have been adopted and followed by hundreds of colleges and universities in the United States

### ACADEMIC ATTIRE

Today, all candidates for degrees and those who hold degrees, including college officials, faculty, and visiting dignitaries, are attired in traditional cap and gown. The formal color for most caps and gowns is black. However, holders of different degrees wear distinctive tassels on their caps (called mortarboards). Hoods of various hues drape down the back of the gowns. Recipients of the associate and bachelor degrees at Northern Kentucky University wear black gowns and black tassels: recipients of the master and doctoral degrees wear black gowns and tassels that correspond to the color of their particular discipline; and recipients of the degree of Juris Doctor wear black gowns and purple tassels.

Those wearing academic costumes wear caps in the academic processions and throughout the ceremony. Men may remove their caps during prayer or at other specified times.

Members of the University governing body are entitled to wear doctoral gowns. The Regents regalia is a gold gown with three black chevrons and trim and an eight-sided tam with gold tassel. This attire is distinctive of the Board of Regents of Northern Kentucky University.

### INTERNATIONAL SASHES

Different flags are displayed on colorful sashes worn by international students and those students who studied abroad during their time at NKU. The sashes display the flag or emblem commemorating a student's favorite study abroad location or the original country of birth or citizenship of an international student.

### HONORS CORDS

The gold and white Honors Cords worn by bachelor degree graduates signify that they have achieved at least a 3.5 cumulative overall grade-point average on a 4.0 scale for their academic careers. The black and white Honors Cords are worn by those associate degree graduates with at least a 3.5 cumulative overall grade-point average.

Purple and silver cords are worn by members of the Norse Leadership Society, a board of student leaders who plan leadership and personal development opportunities for the campus and students in the community. Membership is limited to students who have demonstrated leadership ability on the campus and in the community and who have maintained a required cumulative grade-point average.

### **GRAND MARSHAL**

The Grand Marshal is the President of the Faculty Senate, or his/her designate, and represents the faculty. President Steven Weiss holds this honor today.

### **STUDENT MARSHALS**

The students in gold gowns are Student Marshals. They have been selected on the basis of outstanding records of scholastic achievement.

### **PRESIDENTIAL AMBASSADORS**

Student ushers are Presidential Ambassadors. They are selected on the basis of their records of scholastic achievement and their ability to serve the University.

### THE UNIVERSITY MACE

The mace, which traces its roots to medieval weaponry, has become a symbol of scholarship and integrity for universities since the eleventh century. Today, the University's Grand Marshal carries the mace to indicate the solemnity of the occasion and the confirmation of the academic process.

Northern Kentucky University's mace is rich in symbolism. The spiral base, made of walnut-stained mahogany, suggests growth, evolution and higher achievement. The gold-leaf flame, inspired by NKU's official seal, the lamp of learning, symbolizes eternal light and learning. The gold and white braided cords flowing from the base of the flame represent purity as well as Northern's school colors.

The mace was presented as a gift to the University from the Northern Kentucky University Foundation, Inc. It was designed by Kari Messner '91 and was sculpted by local artist Jack True. Northern Kentucky University is proud of its diverse student body including students representing 60 countries. International flags displayed on stage today represent those countries:


