It is proper you should know that I am keeping my account here with C. Ashworth No 10. Pine St. [Street] and that I am a joint partner with G. W. Bishop in the purchase of Gold held in the name of Bishop Bro with Clark Dodge & Co Wall St. [Street] this is however strictly confidential don't mention it to any one I have a writen [written] contract with Bishop Bro in my possesion [possession]. Tare [Tear] this off and keep it as a memorandum [memorandum].
