Andrea Shiverdecker, a non-traditional student, began her bachelor's degree 20 years ago after graduating from Larry A. Ryle High School in 1999. She attended Eastern Kentucky University for a short period before her marriage to her husband, Dusty. Following the September 11th tragedy, she joined the U.S. Air Force. After a military enlistment and a subsequent career as a professional dog groomer, she eventually returned to college in January 2017 to finish her degree at Northern Kentucky University.

Andrea found anthropology by chance, and it changed her life. As a research fellow with NKU's Parker Academy Project, funded by the National Science Foundation Research

Experience for Undergraduates grant, Andrea was able to gain a variety of experience with real-world tasks, including historical archiving, document analysis and transcription, archaeology and artifact analysis. She also served as digital curator and photographer for the project and maintained the program's social media accounts and website. As a result of her work on this project, Andrea produced two publications that were featured on both state and national archaeological community blogs.

Andrea also participated in a study abroad project in Belize to study the sugar cane industry and its impact on the local villages and communities. She won both an NKU International Study Abroad scholarship and the Cooperative Center for Study Abroad Storytellers Scholarship for her research in Belize, some of which can be seen on Instagram @blue_2_orange.

During her time at NKU, Andrea became a lifetime member of the National Society of Leadership and Success, Sigma Alpha Pi and the Lambda Alpha National Anthropology Honor Society. She was an NKU Institute of Student Research and Creative Activity featured researcher in July 2018 and was a member of the Dean's List every semester since returning to college. As treasurer and president of the Norse Student Anthropology Society, Andrea created and organized guest speakers, community outreach events and the now-annual community philanthropy donation and direct distribution event, "Warm the Homeless," which aids the local homeless community in toiletries and warm clothing during the winter months.

Andrea is excited about where her future could lead after graduation, and hopes to attend graduate school in the upcoming year to pursue a Ph.D. in Mesoamerican Archaeology so she can teach and share anthropology with the world.



COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER AND THE 2018 FRANK SINTON MILBURN OUTSTANDING PROFESSOR AWARD RECIPIENT



DAVID A. SINGLETON

Professor of Law

David Singleton, professor of law, joined the faculty at NKU's Chase College of Law in 2007 and has since made a dramatic impact on the university and the region.

Singleton received his J.D., cum laude, from Harvard Law School in 1991, and his A.B. in Economics and Public Policy Studies from Duke University in 1987. Upon graduation from law school, Singleton received a Skadden Fellowship to work at the Legal Action Center for the Homeless in New York City, where he practiced for three years. He then worked as a public defender for seven years, first with the Neighborhood Defender Service of Harlem and then with the Public Defender Service for the District of Columbia.

After moving to Cincinnati in 2001, Singleton practiced at Thompson Hine before joining the Ohio Justice and Policy Center (OJPC) as its executive director in July 2002. The OJPC is a non-partisan, nonprofit law office whose purpose is to reform Ohio's justice system. Professor Singleton regularly involves students in the work of the center through which they work with other lawyers, interview current and formerly incarcerated clients, and even occasionally present arguments in court on behalf of clients.

This experiential learning teaches future lawyers about justice by incorporating real-life, high-profile cases into his classes, such as the highly-publicized case of his client, Tyra Patterson, who was released after serving more than 21 years in a Dayton prison for a crime she did not commit. He also engages his students by inviting them to accompany him on client visits when possible.

"I always try and talk about the humanity of folks I represent," he says. "I tell people why I do it. For some people, they might not do what I do or understand why I do what I do, but I at least can share as many experiences as I can about the people I represent."

Singleton also serves as the director of the Chase Constitutional Litigation Clinic, which was created in partnership with the Greater Cincinnati Foundation. The clinic provides students with hands-on experience in actual civil rights cases; this experience includes interviewing clients, writing appellate briefs and delivering oral arguments to the court. Students litigate on behalf of prisoners and former offenders in federal and state court.

"I ask everyone to suspend his or her judgment and give the people they represent a chance," Singleton says. "Don't judge them on the worst things they've done. We're all people, and some make mistakes that land us in prison. That doesn't mean clients have lost their humanity. We fight for people because they're human beings."

Singleton helps people in the criminal justice system who many have turned their backs on, and he doesn't plan on quitting anytime soon.

"I'm going to keep doing what I do until they roll me out in a pine box," he says. "It's a calling for me. I'm so blessed to be able to use my time and my talents to help people that few lawyers want to spend their time with."

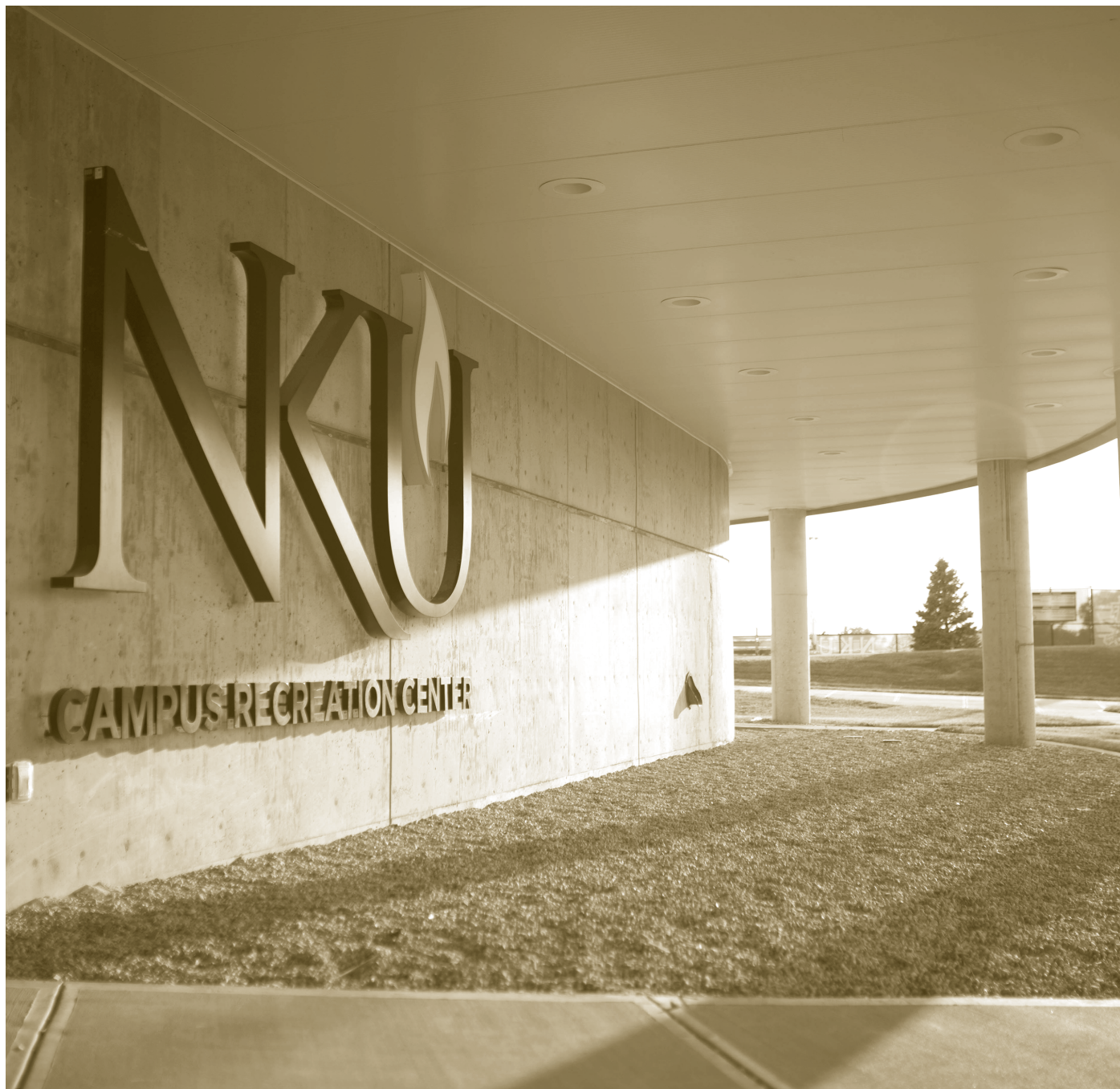

DAVID A. SINGLETON

Professor of Law

David Singleton, Professor of Law, joined the faculty at NKU's Chase College of Law in 2007 and has since had a dramatic impact on the university and the region.

Singleton received his J.D., cum laude, from Harvard Law School in 1991, and his A.B. in Economics and Public Policy Studies from Duke University in 1987. Upon graduation from law school, Singleton received a Skadden Fellowship to work at the Legal Action Center for the Homeless in New York City, where he practiced for three years. He then worked as a public defender for seven years, first with the Neighborhood Defender Service of Harlem and then with the Public Defender Service for the District of Columbia.

After moving to Cincinnati in 2001, Singleton practiced at Thompson Hine before joining the Ohio Justice and Policy Center (OJPC) as its Executive Director in July 2002. The OJPC is a non-partisan, nonprofit law office whose purpose is to reform Ohio's justice system. Professor Singleton regularly involves students in the work of the center through which they work with other lawyers, interview current and formerly incarcerated clients, and even occasionally present arguments in court on behalf of clients.

This experiential learning teaches future lawyers about justice by incorporating real-life, high-profile cases into his classes, such as the highly-publicized case of his client, Tyra Patterson, who has been released after serving more than 21 years in a Dayton prison for a crime she did not commit. He also engages his students by inviting them to accompany him on client visits when possible.

"I always try and talk about the humanity of folks I represent," he says. "I tell people why I do it. For some people, they might not do what I do or understand why I do what I do, but I at least can share as many experiences as I can about the people I represent."

Singleton also serves as the director of the Chase Constitutional Litigation Clinic, which was created in partnership with the Greater Cincinnati Foundation. The clinic provides students with hands-on experience in actual civil rights cases; this experience includes interviewing clients, writing appellate briefs, and delivering oral arguments to the court. Students litigate on behalf of prisoners and former offenders in federal and state court.

"I ask everyone to suspend his or her judgment and give the people they represent a chance," Singleton says. "Don't judge them on the worst things they've done. We're all people, and some make mistakes that land us in prison. That doesn't mean clients have lost their humanity. We fight for people because they're human beings."

Singleton helps people in the criminal justice system who many have turned their backs on, and he doesn't plan on quitting anytime soon.

"I'm going to keep doing what I do until they roll me out in a pine box," he says. "It's a calling for me. I'm so blessed to be able to use my time and my talents to help people that few lawyers want to spend their time with."

COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY

Commencement exercises today at Northern Kentucky University give special attention to the pageantry of the ceremony. The counterpart of this pageantry is enacted each year on campuses all over the world. It is the solemn climax and recognition of the graduates' years of study and preparation for increased responsibility.

HISTORY OF ACADEMIC COSTUME

The history of academic dress reaches far back into the early days of the oldest universities. A statute of 1321 required that all "Doctors, Licentiates, and Bachelors" of the University of Coimbra wear gowns. In England, in the second half of the fourteenth century, the statutes of certain colleges forbade "excess in apparel" and prescribed the wearing of a long gown. It is still unknown whether academic dress finds its sources chiefly in ecclesiastical or in civilian dress. Gowns may have been counted necessary for warmth in the unheated buildings frequented by medieval scholars. Hoods seem to have served to cover the tonsured head until they were superseded by skull caps. These were themselves displaced by a headress somewhat like those now recognized as "academic." Both Cambridge and Oxford have made academic dress a matter of university control to the extent of minor details and have repeatedly issued revised regulations governing it. In seventeenth-century Oxford it was prescribed that any tailor who departed from the authorized design "by a nail's breadth" in the making of any article of collegiate costume was to be punished by the vice-chancellor of the university.

European institutions continue to show a great diversity in their specifications of academic dress, while American colleges and universities have adopted, through the Intercollegiate Bureau of Academic Costume and the American Council of Education, a standard code of dress for academic ceremony. Created in 1902, the Intercollegiate Bureau of Academic Costume serves as a source of information and guidance in such matters and, through occasional review by the American Council of Education, these standards have been adopted and followed by hundreds of colleges and universities in the United States.

ACADEMIC ATTIRE

Today, all candidates for degrees and those who hold degrees, including college officials, faculty and visiting dignitaries, are attired in traditional cap and gown. The formal color for most caps and gowns is black. However, holders of different degrees wear distinctive tassels on their caps (called mortarboards). Hoods of various hues drape down the back of the gowns. Recipients of the associate and bachelor degrees at Northern Kentucky University wear black gowns and black tassels; recipients of the master and doctoral degrees wear black gowns and tassels that correspond to the color of their particular discipline; and recipients of the degree of Juris Doctor wear black gowns and purple tassels.

Those wearing academic costumes wear caps in the academic processions and throughout the ceremony. Men may remove their caps during prayer or at other specified times.

Members of the University governing body are entitled to wear doctoral gowns. The Regents regalia is a gold gown with three black chevrons and trim and an eight-sided tam with gold tassel. This attire is distinctive of the Board of Regents of Northern Kentucky University.

INTERNATIONAL SASHES

Different flags are displayed on colorful sashes worn by international students and those students who studied abroad during their time at NKU. The sashes display the flag or emblem commemorating a student's favorite study abroad location or the original country of birth or citizenship of an international student.

HONORS CORDS

The gold and white Honors Cords worn by bachelor degree graduates signify that they have achieved at least a 3.5 cumulative overall grade-point average on a 4.0 scale for their academic careers. The black and white Honors Cords are worn by those associate degree graduates with at least a 3.5 cumulative overall grade-point average.

Purple and silver cords are worn by members of the Norse Leadership Society, a board of student leaders who plan leadership and personal development opportunities for the campus and students in the community. Membership is limited to students who have demonstrated leadership ability on the campus and in the community and who have maintained a required cumulative grade-point average.

GRAND MARSHAL

The Grand Marshal is the President of the Faculty Senate, or his/her designate, and represents the faculty. President Matthew Zacate holds this honor today.

STUDENT MARSHALS

The students in gold gowns are Student Marshals. They have been selected on the basis of outstanding records of scholastic achievement.

PRESIDENTIAL AMBASSADORS

Student ushers are Presidential Ambassadors. They are selected on the basis of their records of scholastic achievement and their ability to serve the University.

THE UNIVERSITY MACE

The mace, which traces its roots to medieval weaponry, has become a symbol of scholarship and integrity for universities since the eleventh century. Today, the University's Grand Marshal carries the mace to indicate the solemnity of the occasion and the confirmation of the academic process.

Northern Kentucky University's mace is rich in symbolism. The spiral base, made of walnut-stained mahogany, suggests growth, evolution and higher achievement. The gold-leaf flame, inspired by NKU's official seal, the lamp of learning, symbolizes eternal light and learning. The gold and white braided cords flowing from the base of the flame represent purity as well as Northern's school colors.

The mace was presented as a gift to the University from the Northern Kentucky University Foundation, Inc. It was designed by Kari Messner '91 and was sculpted by local artist Jack True.
