April 14 Meeting Summary

President Linda Wright reported that the Staff Regent committee is developing rules and regulations to govern the election of a staff regent; they are determining eligibility criteria to hold the position, and criteria for voting. Linda clarified who would be represented by the staff regent: all employees of NKU excluding faculty (those represented by Faculty Senate), deans, the president, and vice presidents. Staff Congress will have a role in conducting the election, but it is a larger campus concern, since the presentation encompasses more staff than are represented by Staff Congress.

A Special Staff Congress meeting will be held Thursday, April 28, at 1:00 p.m. in Administrative Center Room 722 to address the staff regent election process.

Staff Congress election process is underway. Nomination forms were mailed April 18 and are due back in the Staff Congress Office by this Friday, April 29. Please consider nominating yourself or another staff member to serve. Voting ballots will be mailed the week of May 9.

The committee working on Temporary Disability has finished their work, and submitted the final resolutions to President Boothe for final approval.

The next Board of Regents meeting is scheduled on Wednesday, May 4, 1994, in the Regents Board Room on the 8th Floor of the Administrative Center.

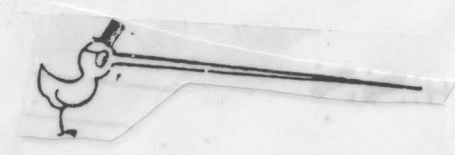
