A. D. ALBRIGHT SCHOLARSHIP

Applications for the A. D. Albright Scholarship for 1984-85 are currently being accepted by the Financial Aid Office, AC 416. Application forms may be obtained at Personnel Services, AC 708.

The applicant must:

1. be the son or daughter of an NKU staff member (as defined in Article I of the Constitution of the Northern Kentucky University Staff Congress), and must register for 12 or more semester hours in undergraduate studies;
2. have an Admissions application on file with the University;
3. submit three (3) reference letters from teachers and/or employers;
4. submit verification of ACT scores, high school and/or college transcripts or a GED score, if such documents are not currently on file with the University;
5. submit a completed application along with the above mentioned attachments by April 9, 1984 to the NKU Financial Aid Office, ATTN: Cathy Dewberry;

Financial need will be considered only in the case of a tie. If such should occur, a financial need analysis would then be required of the applicants in question.
