

# FAMILY DENTAL PLAN

Dr. Boothe has given approval to the Personnel Office to, once again, offer Family Plan Dental to eligible employees.

A letter, application and waiver form with a description of the plan will be forthcoming. A two party, as well as Family Plan, will be offered. Remember, in order for the University to offer Family Dental, 75% of eligible members must participate. Employees whose families are covered by spouses plan will count toward the 75%. Our target date for enrollment will be before Thanksgiving Break with coverage effective January 1, 1987. Costs will be:

Two-party Plan: \$ 7.46 per month - monthly personnel

\$ 3.73 per pay period - bi-weekly personnel

Family Plan: \$12.40 per month - monthly personnel

\$ 6.20 per pay period - bi-weekly personnel
