DENTAL INSURANCE

Effective January 1, 1983, the dental insurance rate for 1983 will increase from \$6.62 to \$9.60 per month per employee, an increase of 45%.

During the first 9 month period, a total of 235 employees received \$35,888 of benefits. In total, and covering all types of services, the plan paid for 60.4% of the amount of all dental bills submitted.

Our usage during the first 9 months of the plan was 28% higher than the premiums the university paid to Delta Dental.
