Regents Distinguished Service Award

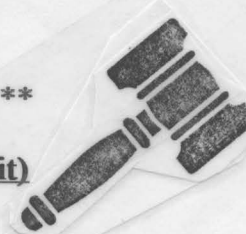
Please be reminded that all nominations for this award must be in by Friday, September 23, 1994.
