Cherokee Co. N.C. [County, North Carolina]

Dr [Dear] Sir

On the 20th Jan last I wrote the Treasurer of your County to inform the amt. [amount] of Tax and when due on 640 acres of Land in Cherokee Co. dede [dede] to R.L. Green and recorded in Book P. page 358 And as soon as informed I would remit the money.

Getting no reply to the above I wrote again on the 13 March last asking the same information – to which I recd [received] no reply.

And on 17 Apl [April] last I wrote the Post Master asking the favour [favor] of him to give me the Address of the Tax Collector and Treasurer and also the address of one of your best Real Estate agents and Lawyers

In each of these letters I enclosed postage stamps, but neither they, or any

reply have been returned and up to this date I am uninformed as to the amt. [amount] tax due, which I am ready to pay on said Land.

And write this to ask the favour [favor] of you to give me the information asked above. Your compliance [compliance] will greatly Oblige Yours Truly
