On the 20th Jan last I wrote the Treasurer of your County to inform the amt. [amount] of Tax and when due on 640 acres of Land in Cherokee Co. deded [deeded] to R.L. Green and recorded in Book P. page 358 And as soon as informed I would remit the money.

Getting no reply to the above I wrote again on the 13 March last asking the same information – to which I recd [received] no reply.

And on 17 Apl [April] last I wrote the Post Master asking the favour [favor] of him to give me the Addressof the Tax Collector and Treasurer and also the address of one of your best Real Estate agents and Lawyers

In each of these letters I enclosed postage stamps, but neither they, or any

reply have been returned and up to this date I am uninformed as to the amt. [amount] tax due, which I am ready to pay on said Land.
