During Brandi's time as a student, she has worked to improve the diversity of the student body in the College of Education and Human Services. In partnership with two other students, she founded Black and Brown Educators of Excellence at NKU, an organization dedicated to improving support for minority students. Black and Brown Educators of Excellence strives to recruit and empower the next generation of minority students, learners, and educators, and motivate them to strive for the highest success academically, mentally, socially, physically, and emotionally. With support from the College of Education and Human Services, Black and Brown Educators of Excellence has expanded membership, conducted community service events, and shared member stories at the college's fall 2016 and spring 2017 Think Tank events.

In the future, Brandi plans to continue working with NKU's student engagement office and to further her education in graduate school. In the long term, she plans to become a school principal or open her own school for minority children. In her free time, Brandi loves to dance, sing, and have a good laugh. ### COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER AND HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENT

The Board of Regents at Northern Kentucky University is pleased to award an honorary degree to Virginia G. Fox.

### **DOCTOR OF EDUCATION**

Virginia Fox is a seventh generation Kentuckian who holds a bachelor's degree in elementary education from Morehead State University and a master's degree in library science from the University of Kentucky. Fox began her distinguished career in education as an elementary school teacher and librarian. After seven years in these roles, she was one of only ten employees hired as a Utilization Specialist for Kentucky Educational Television (KET).

Fox's career in and service to education was and continues to be the result of her strong commitment to access regardless of age, circumstance, or geographic location; her firm belief in the importance of data-driven decision making; and the importance of applying digital technology to education, public services, and civic engagement.

Fox exhibited the strength of her beliefs through the creation of KET's GED on TV series which has been used in all 50 states, worldwide by more than 200 U.S. armed services bases, federal and state correctional systems and several foreign countries. This series, now delivered digitally, has given millions of people a second chance for post-secondary education and enhanced employment opportunities.

As CEO of Kentucky Educational Television, she oversaw the creation of KET 1 and KET 2 in preparation for digital broadcast delivery, made KET the most prolific producer of educational as well as local programming in the nation, and persuaded the Kentucky

General Assembly to be one of the first public television licensees to meet the FCC mandate for digital delivery system.

In 2003, Fox was appointed as the Secretary of Education for the Commonwealth of Kentucky. In her time as secretary, Fox used the opportunity to advocate for better collection, analysis and application of P-20 data to policy making entities, encourage more collaboration with business and community leaders, and helped better align K-12 standards with postsecondary and business expectations. Fox also successfully advocated for the transition of KET's Network Broadcast Center from analog to digital technology.

Ms. Fox has received numerous awards for her achievements in education and public service, including the Corporation of Public Broadcasting Lifetime Achievement Award in 2002 and the National School Public Relations Association Learning and Liberty Award in 2004. She was the 2007 recipient of the General Educational Development Testing Service Lifetime Achievement Award presented by the American Council on Education

During her ten years of retirement, Fox has remained quite active in education and in her community. She currently serves as a member and secretary of the Northern Kentucky University Board of Regents, a member of the board of Midway University, and Treasurer of the Clark Foundation. She has been happily married for 53 years to attorney Victor Fox, USN Captain Retired with over 42 years of service. Though they have no children, they are deeply invested in a number of great and grand nieces and nephews who bring them much joy. In addition to education, the Foxs are active in support of no-kill and rescue animal operations.

### **COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER**



RICHARD A. BOEHNE '81 Chairman, President and CEO The E. W. Scripps Company Chair, Northern Kentucky University Board of Regents

As a long-time news and media industry leader, Rich Boehne is among NKU's most recognizable alumni. He's also among the university's most active alumni, serving currently as chair of NKU's Board of Regents.

Boehne developed a passion for news and current events while growing up in Northern Kentucky on a steady diet of the newspapers that served the Commonwealth and Greater Cincinnati. While a student at Highlands High School, in Ft. Thomas, KY, he launched his own media career selling subscriptions to *The Cincinnati Post* and *The Kentucky Post*. While in college, he worked for *The Cincinnati Enquirer*.

In 1981, following a few fits and starts, he received a degree in mass communication/journalism from NKU. He left campus immediately following commencement to cover a community event for a small weekly newspaper in southern Ohio. Three years later, he moved to *The Cincinnati Post* where

he worked as a reporter and editor focusing primarily on business issues, the stock market and the economy.

Boehne moved from The Cincinnati Post to its parent company's corporate staff in 1988 to help The E.W. Scripps Company with its conversion to a publicly traded enterprise. Over the next 20 years, he held various roles and his career progressed as the company rapidly expanded from newspapers and broadcast television to include some of America's most popular cable brands, including Home & Garden Television, Food Network and DIY, and began investing to build digital media brands distributed over the internet. He was elected executive vice president of the company in 1999 and chief operating officer in 2006. In 2008, Scripps spun off the cable networks into a separate lifestyle media company and Boehne was elected president and CEO of the journalism-focused E.W. Scripps Company. Scripps exited the newspaper business in 2015 through a deal that also substantially expanded its television and digital operations.

Today, Cincinnati-based Scripps is one of the nation's most entrepreneurial news and media companies, operating one of the industry's largest local television groups and producing popular TV shows for itself and other television companies. Scripps also operates an awardwinning national investigative reporting group based in Washington, D.C.; owns the growing Midroll podcast network, as well as owning and producing some of today's most popular podcast shows.

The company also is aggressively building Newsy, an award-winning news network aimed at younger audiences. Newsy can be seen today on most streaming TV services, including Apple TV, Roku and Sling, and is expanding its reach on cable and satellite services.

As CEO of the company, Boehne receives his 15 minutes of fame each spring when he awards the trophy at the Scripps National Spelling Bee live on ESPN. This year marks the 90th year of the national contest, which debuted on television 24 years ago and has mesmerized

audiences in primetime for the past 12 years. The Bee, which Scripps operates as a non-profit promotion for spelling, language and education, begins with nearly 11 million students from more than 26,000 schools in the US and more each year from other nations.

In late 2017, Boehne plans to retire from his president and CEO duties at Scripps while remaining the company's chair of the board. He took over as the top executive just in time to guide Scripps through the worldwide financial crisis of 2008-2010, and he leaves an enterprise that has enjoyed financial success by being entrepreneurial, risk-tolerant and deeply committed to public service. His casual style, commitment to journalism and passionate advocacy for free speech are reflected across the Scripps culture.

Boehne met his future spouse and fellow journalism student, Lisa Graybeal, on NKU's campus in 1979. They graduated together in 1981 and married soon after. The younger of their two sons also is an NKU grad. He works today as a K-12 teacher in Cincinnati.

In the media industry, Boehne serves on the board of the Associated Press, one of the world's leading news organizations. In 2016 he received the industry's First Amendment Leadership Award, honoring his advocacy for First Amendment and free speech rights. Boehne has received the NKU Professional Achievement Award (1996), Outstanding Alumnus Award (2001) and Lincoln Award (2012). He was appointed by the governor of Kentucky to the university's board of regents in 2012.

He's active in numerous community efforts across Greater Cincinnati and Kentucky. He's past chairman of the Cincinnati USA Regional Chamber of Commerce and served multiple terms on the board of Cincinnati's Freestore Foodbank.

In recent years, he has returned to his family's agricultural roots as the owner of a small but expanding farm operation in Morning View, Kentucky.

### **COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY**

Commencement exercises today at Northern Kentucky University give special attention to the pageantry of the ceremony. The counterpart of this pageantry is enacted each year on campuses all over the world. It is the solemn climax and recognition of the graduates' years of study and preparation for increased responsibility.

#### **HISTORY OF ACADEMIC COSTUME**

The history of academic dress reaches far back into the early days of the oldest universities. A statute of 1321 required that all "Doctors, Licentiates, and Bachelors" of the University of Coimbra wear gowns. In England, in the second half of the fourteenth century, the statutes of certain colleges forbade "excess in apparel" and prescribed the wearing of a long gown. It is still unknown whether academic dress finds its sources chiefly in ecclesiastical or in civilian dress. Gowns may have been counted necessary for warmth in the unheated buildings frequented by medieval scholars. Hoods seem to have served to cover the tonsured head until they were superseded by skull caps. These were themselves displaced by a headdress somewhat like those now recognized as "academic." Both Cambridge and Oxford have made academic dress a matter of university control to the extent of minor details and have repeatedly issued revised regulations governing it. In seventeenth-century Oxford it was prescribed that any tailor who departed from the authorized design "by a nail's breadth" in the making of any article of collegiate costume was to be punished by the vice-chancellor of the university.

European institutions continue to show a great diversity in their specifications of academic dress, while American colleges and universities have adopted, through the Intercollegiate Bureau of Academic Costume and the American Council of Education, a standard code of dress for academic ceremony. Created in 1902, the Intercollegiate Bureau of Academic Costume serves as a source of information and guidance in such matters and, through occasional review by the American Council of Education, these standards have been adopted and followed by hundreds of colleges and universities in the United States.

### **COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY** CONTINUED

#### **ACADEMIC ATTIRE**

Today, all candidates for degrees and those who hold degrees, including college officials, faculty, and visiting dignitaries, are attired in traditional cap and gown. The formal color for most caps and gowns is black. However, holders of different degrees wear distinctive tassels on their caps (called mortarboards). Hoods of various hues drape down the back of the gowns. Recipients of the associate and bachelor degrees at Northern Kentucky University wear black gowns and black tassels; recipients of the master and doctoral degrees wear black gowns and tassels that correspond to the color of their particular discipline; and recipients of the degree of Juris Doctor wear black gowns and purple tassels.

Those wearing academic costumes wear caps in the academic processions and throughout the ceremony. Men may remove their caps during prayer or at other specified times.

Members of the University governing body are entitled to wear doctoral gowns. The Regents regalia is a gold gown with three black chevrons and trim and an eight-sided tam with gold tassel. This attire is distinctive of the Board of Regents of Northern Kentucky University.

### **INTERNATIONAL SASHES**

Different flags are displayed on colorful sashes worn by international students and those students who studied abroad during their time at NKU. The sashes display the flag or emblem commemorating a student's favorite study abroad location or the original country of birth or citizenship of an international student.

#### **HONORS CORDS**

The gold and white Honors Cords worn by bachelor degree graduates signify that they have achieved at least a 3.5 cumulative overall grade-point average on a 4.0 scale for their academic careers. The black and white Honors Cords are worn by those associate degree graduates with at least a 3.5 cumulative overall grade-point average.

Purple and silver cords are worn by members of the Norse Leadership Society, a board of student leaders who plan leadership and personal development opportunities for the campus and students in the community. Membership is limited to students who have demonstrated leadership ability on the campus and in the community and who have maintained a required cumulative grade-point average.

### **GRAND MARSHAL**

The Grand Marshal is the President of the Faculty Senate, or his/her designate, and represents the faculty. President Michael Baranowski holds this honor today.

#### **STUDENT MARSHALS**

The students in gold gowns are Student Marshals. They have been selected on the basis of outstanding records of scholastic achievement.

### PRESIDENTIAL AMBASSADORS

Student ushers are Presidential Ambassadors. They are selected on the basis of their records of scholastic achievement and their ability to serve the University.

#### THE UNIVERSITY MACE

The mace, which traces its roots to medieval weaponry, has become a symbol of scholarship and integrity for universities since the eleventh century. Today, the University's Grand Marshal carries the mace to indicate the solemnity of the occasion and the confirmation of the academic process.

Northern Kentucky University's mace is rich in symbolism. The spiral base, made of walnut-stained mahogany, suggests growth, evolution and higher achievement. The gold-leaf flame, inspired by NKU's official seal, the lamp of learning, symbolizes eternal light and learning. The gold and white braided cords flowing from the base of the flame represent purity as well as Northern's school colors.

The mace was presented as a gift to the University from the Northern Kentucky University Foundation, Inc. It was designed by Kari Messner '91 and was sculpted by local artist Jack True.
