[Letter from Frederick C. Sharon to F.P. Axley, Jan 1904]

Kansas City [Missouri], Jan, 22, 1904 [January 22, 1904].

Mr. F.P. Axley,
Murphy, N.C. [North Carolina]

Dear Sir: -

I have your letter of the 11th., and had intended coming down to see you about this land belinging [belonging] to my wife but find I cant [can't] get away; I am, therefore, relying on your judgment, which I feel sure is correct.

My wife seems a little bit reluctant to sell for \$3.50 an acre, but after thinking the matter over she says that if you can get these people to pay this price net, and in addition your fees and commissions, she will accept it. Will you please therefore get definite answer from Mr. Barker on this proposition and let me know at your early [earliest] convenience.

I will be out of town for a few days but expect to be back by January 31st,
