President's Notes by Linda Wright

Re-elected to second terms at the July meeting were Jay Stevens, Secretary; Chuck Pettit, President-Elect; and myself as President. We look forward to another year of hard work with Staff Congress.

Committee assignments were announced (see below), and chairs were chosen. Standing committees have been asked to convene before our August meeting to review past work and discuss responsibilities and goals. Questions and concerns may be addressed to any committee member.

In the April newsletter, it was reported that Staff Congress was looking into the possibility of reinvesting health insurance utilization savings into the wellness program in an effort to keep utilization down. We have learned that approximately \$100,000 in savings has been recaptured into the fixed cost pool. This, understandably, was necessary due to state budget cuts. However, we are working with administration on using approximately \$8,000 from the wellness account for wellness issues. Examples of such uses are listed below. Thanks to Sue Roth in particular for pursuing this idea. We will keep you updated on further action.

- \* Satellite health issues (convenience access)
- \* Testing Fees (covering costs to encourage use)
- \* Equipment (to upgrade existing facilities)

Virginia Stallings has offered to be a legislative liaison in Frankfort during the General Assembly to lobby for staff representation on the Board of Regents. We will have several staff members working with her as well. Please give them your support in this important issue.
