CHANGE IN HEALTH PLAN EXPLORED

A change in the University's health insurance plan from the current Blue Cross/Blue Shield coverage to the state employees' plan is currently under negotiation. In a recent joint session of Staff Congress and Faculty Senate, Gregg Schulte of Personnel Services explained that the University wished to make a bid to become part of the state group. This would result in an estimated savings of some \$400,000 to the University in 1986-87, and \$30 per month savings for family plan holders. Lower premiums are made possible by the size of the state group (approximately 80,000 members) and by the relatively low health care costs around the state as compared to rates in our area.

The state is expected to respond soon to NKU's request, as the closing date for bids from health insurance carriers is April 18th.

On a related note, the University is required to provide an HMO (health maintenance organization, such as Choice Care) as an option for health care coverage by July 1st. Bids have been received from various HMO's, and the selection process is underway.

More information on health insurance will be provided as it becomes available.
