A. D. ALBRIGHT SCHOLARSHIP UPDATE (Let's try it one more time. . .)

The 1984-85 A. D. Albright Scholarship deadline has been extended to April 16, 1984. Few applications have been received to date by the Financial Aid Office in AC 416, prompting this reiteration of the requirements. Application forms may be obtained at Personnel Services, AC 708.

The applicant must:

1. be the son or daughter of an NKU staff member, and must register for 12 or more semester hours in undergraduate studies;
2. have an Admissions application on file with the University;
3. submit three (3) reference letters from teachers and/or employers;
4. submit verification of ACT scores, high school and/or college transcripts or a GED score, if not currently on file with the University;
5. submit a completed application along with the above mentioned attachments by April 16, 1984 to the NKU Financial Aid Office, ATTN: Cathy Dewberry;

- Six hundred and nine donors, 72% of all potential staff and faculty participants, contributed a total of over \$42,000.00, and this total is expected to rise
- Twenty-nine departments achieved 100% participation

Thanks to those of us who made the drive a success by contributing, special thanks to those employees who acted as department coordinators, and special recognition and thanks is deserved by those staff volunteers who went far beyond the expected level of effort.

One example of such extra effort is Lora Cann in the Accounting Department. She was able to obtain 100% participation from Accounting. To generate interest, Lora kicked off the drive by baking a cake topped with a delicious American flag icing; she used strawberries for the red bars, and blueberries for the field of blue topped with icing stars.

She also prepared posters and graphs to keep all staff in the Accounting Department continually aware of the drive activity.

Lora's crowning touch was an eight-foot-long poster of the "NKU Express", a steam engine pulling cars loaded with pictures of accounting employees' children and grandchildren, as these children are the ones who will ultimately benefit from a strong University supported by the faculty, staff, students, and surrounding community.

Again, thanks to Lora and to all who worked and contributed to make the Annual Fund drive a success.
