

Minutes of the Faculty Senate Meeting of September 23, 1974

The senate was called to order at 3:35 p.m.

President Williams reported that he proposes to initiate discussion with Dr. Steely and other members of the Administration to devise a method of systematic review of the upcoming budget.

Reports were given by the Academic Affairs Committee, Faculty Affairs Committee, and Student Affairs Committee.

Mike Hur submitted a motion to invite the Curriculum Committee of the College to appear before the Senate for a question-and-answer session. The motion was seconded by Leonidas Sarakatsannis. After discussion the motion was defeated by voice vote.

After discussion of the present Tenure Committee deliberations, the President of the Senate assured the Senate that any proposals on tenure which might come before the Administrative Council would be discussed fully in the Senate, at a special meeting if necessary, thus insuring that the Senate's representatives in Administrative Council would reflect faculty opinion.

The meeting was adjourned.
