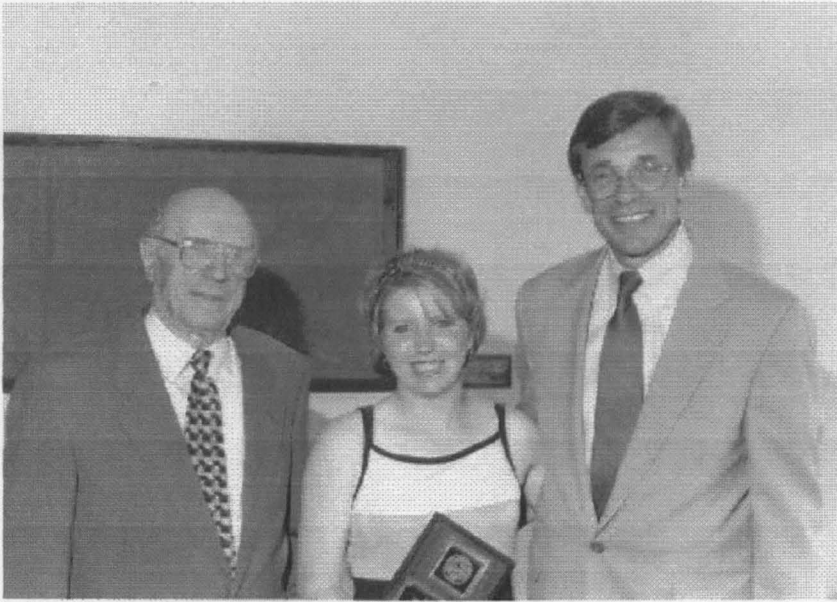
New Arrivals

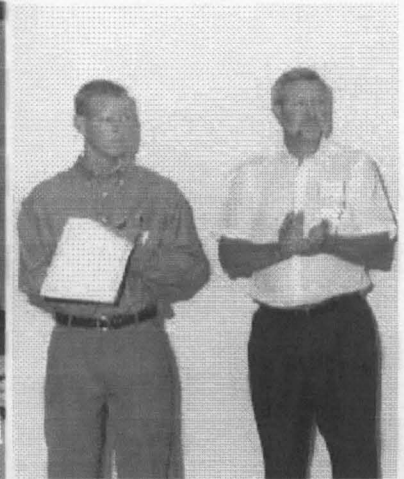
