3% Pay Increase Announced For Staff And Faculty

Interim President Jack Moreland announced a 3% across the board pay increase for staff and faculty as a part of his "State of the University" address last Tuesday.

Speaking to a packed house in the Greaves Auditorium, President Moreland said that NKU has lost too many valuable people and that we must, "Stop the bleeding."

The cost of the pay increase, nearly \$1.2 million, and the decrease in enrollment will further strain the university's budget, but President Moreland said he felt the increase was necessary to keep people from leaving.

"Can we afford this? And my answer to that is can we afford not too." President

Moreland admitted that 3% will not, make the patient well, but it will help.

President Moreland also announced a \$2.2 million commitment to new technology. "It's not a cost, it's an investment," he said, and added that the technology is in the best interests of the students we serve.

Speaking of his Partnerships project, President Moreland pleaded, "Don't be afraid of the Partnerships. It's a community effort to try to make us better."

President Moreland's address concluded with his stressing the need for the university to focus in a common direction. A borrowed theme summed his hopes for the upcoming year, "It's amazing what we can do together."

Elissa Plattner and Robert F. Sexton were named Co-chairs of the Steering Committee. Among the members of the Steering Committee is Staff Congress President Cheryl Torline.
