This trunk belonged to Graeat [Great] grand-ma Fanny Anders Weaver

The cap belonged to her daughter. Grand ma Nancy L. Bruce.

The vail + undersleeves to her grand daughter my Mother Mary E. Bruce

The waist to my self [myself] who is her great grand daughter 19 years of age – 1866.

The sun Bonnet to my son Linden who is her great great grand son - + The drawers were my baby Pauline's, who is also her great great grand daughter – Five generations
