
The Attorney General's opinion was sought by a member of State Senate and should be forthcoming sometime soon, I would think.

STAFF CONGRESS MINUTES November 8, 1984

- I. President Dan Alford called the meeting to order. He apologized for the delay in sending out the October minutes. He then stated that he would conduct the meeting up to the time of the elections, after which the gavel would be turned over to the newly elected president.
- II. The minutes of the October 11th meeting were approved after deletion of Carol Guthier from those absent since she had previously resigned from Congress.

III. President's Report - Dan Alford

- 1. President Alford and Vice-President Linda Sanders met with the Physical Plant personnel on October 14 at two different times, as directed by full Congress. Intentions were to determine a way for encouraging more participation of the Physical Plant as a whole as well as those Physical Plant Congress representatives. Both meetings were well attended; Mr. Barnes had organized them as shifts changed in Nunn Hall. Response was favorable and they do want to be involved, but were concerned about time limitations. The most important point was that they realized they do not have to be an elected member of Staff Congress to participate in the activities. Alford and Sandersemphasized that they would like to have them address the Congress on any issues they feel concerned about. One way to have Physical Plant represented was to have a representative from Physical Plant on Ad-hoc Committees. They stated they do have available break time. The consensus is that Congress for this year should extend a greater effort to work with them. This was presented to Staff Congress so this year's Congress can follow up on their participation.
- 2. The response from Gregg Schulte of Personnel Services to the tuition waiver recommendation was discussed. The recommendation is on hold pending an opinion from the state Attorney General on the legality of extending the waiver to spouse and children. The Executive Committee has met with President Boothe since this memo but has not received any response as yet. This should be followed through by the new Executive Committee.

- 3. A memorandum from Dr. Boothe regarding athletic symbols was discussed. President Alford served on the President's ad-hoc committee. President Boothe is looking for responses from all staff and faculty to this letter by December 14, 1984. This should be shared with your constituents and others. A wider range of response is needed. There is no set date for adoption of the proposals as it will be a gradual change due to media and printing.
- 4. President Alford reported that all Ad-Hoc Committees that had been appointed this year, according to our by-laws, are now disbanded. The upcoming Congress will have to reappoint all Ad-Hoc Committees.

IV. Vice-President's Report - Linda Sanders

Linda made the presentation on behalf of the Congress of the engraved gavel to President Alford. There was a round of applause for work well done.

V. <u>Secretary-Treasurer's Report</u> - Linda Thierbach

Linda reported that Dan's name plate has been engraved and will be on the plaque in Personnel Services.

Elections Committee: Diane Hunley

In the absense of chair, Russ Kerdolff, Diane stated that from approximately 475 eligible voters, 212 voted. This was an increase as 34% voted last year, 45% this year - over a 10% increase. The committee felt that the manner in which the absentee ballots were offered this year was well received. Approximately 70 were recorded as absentee voters.

Positive feedbackwas received on the Candidate Summaries published prior to the election. Letters of regret were sent to the unelected staff and letters of congratulations to the elected representatives.

President Alford complimented the election committee and chair, Russ Kerdolff, for the fine job.

Liaison Committee: Don Gammon

The Committe again expressed their concern regarding lack of effective communications throughout the University.

VII. Unfinished Business:

Pat Coleman Mullins asked for an update regarding the Staff Survey. President Alford stated he has requested the results when the survey is completed.

President Alford also stated if there were any difficulties during the changeover of officers and representatives of Staff Congress he would be available to help outline activities still being worked on.

VIII. New Business:

The president suggested a committee should be appointed from Staff Congress for the survey of staff employees regarding their choice of University colors and nickname. The input of the staff will be recommended to President Boothe.

The meeting was turned over to Gary Eith, Parliamentarian, for election of officers for 1984-85. Becky Timerding and Dolores Thelen were appointed as tellers. The following officers were elected: President, Kathy Dawn; Vice-President, Nancy Utz; Secretary-Treasurer, Cindy Dunaway.

Congratulations were extended to the new officers, and the meeting was turned over to Kathy Dawn.

An appointment was made of a Athletic Symbols Ad-Hoc Committee. The representatives appointed were: Becky Timerding, Linda Thierbach, Sarah Coburn, Dale Adams, Pat Coleman Mullins, and Don Gammon. Don Gammon was appointed chair. The committee was charged to have a report ready for the next Staff Congress meeting since Dr. Boothe had asked for responses prior to December 14.

President Dawn suggested an earlier December meeting due to the Christmas holidays, After general discussion, it was agreed that the December meeting would be held on Thursday, December 6.

IX. Adjournment

Don Gammon made a motion for adjournment, second by Sarah Coburn.



It did not take me long after my arrival to realize that there was very little symmetry in terms of the symbolism connected with Intercollegiate Athletics. I also heard many laments and complaints about this symbolism such as the lack of complimentary school colors when they are matched together.


With our entry now into the Great Lakes Valley Conference, it is necessary that we bring some order to these issues. I, therefore, asked an ad hoc committee to look into this topic. The committee has now made a report which has been reviewed in a preliminary way by the President's Staff. The report contains three issues as follows:

- 1. The nickname of the University be changed from the Norsemen/women to the Northern Kentucky Huskies;
- The official colors of the University be changed from gold and white to navy and gold; and
- 3. The fight song and alma mater remain as they are but that we promote these two important parts of the symbolism of the University's athletic program more vigorously in the future.

If there is any interest on your part regarding this matter, I would appreciate it if you would consult with your peers and constituents regarding the report. Your reactions, if any, should be sent to Dr. Gene Scholes, Vice President for Administration, to whom Athletics reports, by no later than Friday, December 14.

We would like to thank those of you who responded to our questionnaire. One of the recurring responses was the need for additional information concerning the candidates for Staff Congress. In response to these suggestions, each candidate for Staff Congress was asked to complete the Candidate Summary portion of the Nomination Form. Attached are the unedited Candidate Summaries listed in alphabetical order. We hope the additional information will assist you in choosing your Staff Congress representatives.

In addition, for your voting convenience, an Absentee Ballot and an Absentee Ballot Certification are enclosed. All support staff members who have successfully completed the probationary period as determined by the Office of Personnel Services shall be eligible to vote in the October 26, 1984 Staff Congress general election. Anyone who will not be able, or finds it inconvenient, to vote at a poll on election day may vote by Absentee Ballot.

The employment area and employment category in which you are eligible to vote has been marked on the attached ballot. Vote only in the employment area and employment category marked on the ballot. All voters are eligible to vote for at-large representatives. All improperly completed absentee ballots will be voided.

Place your completed absentee ballot in a sealed envelope. Sign the Absentee Ballot Certification form and attach it to the outside of the sealed ballot envelope. Place this envelope inside an Inter-Departmental Mail envelope. This procedure ensures that only eligible staff vote in the election and also guarantees anonymity in casting your vote. Ballots must be received by Diane Hunley, AC 716, by 4:30 p.m. October 24, 1984.
